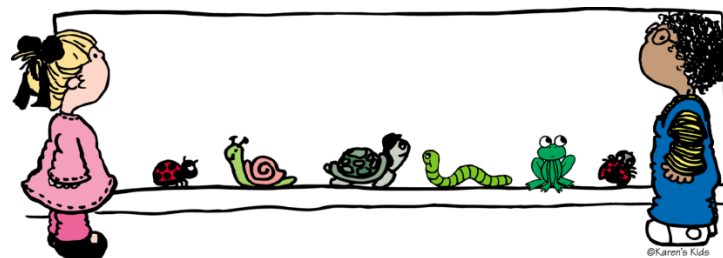
Miss Kaefer is a first year physical education teacher at the School of St. Mary. She is excited to be working with the three and four year old children this summer.

Crusader Camp Programs

All the summer camps are open to St. Mary's students, parishioners, and any members of the surrounding communities. Everyone is welcome!

Camp will be held at the Primary Grade Center Monday through Friday. There will be a two day option, which will meet on Tuesdays and Thursdays as well as a three day option, which will meet on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays.

Campers will be divided by their ages with a camper/teacher ratio of 10:1. Three and four year old children will be with Miss Kaefer. Three year old children must be potty trained by the start of camp. Five and six year old children will be with Miss Dziki. The Lunch Bunch option gives campers an extra hour to eat lunch with their friends and it extends playtime. Campers must provide their own lunches. Additionally, Fridays are Water Day! Campers should come to camp in their swimsuits ready to have fun and get wet!

Campers will be accepted on a first come, first served, basis. The deadline for registration will be May 13th. A late registration fee of \$30 will be charged if campers are registered after this date.
