School Advisory Council (SAC) Provides Strategic Counsel and Support

On November 20, your new SAC convened for the first time to outline an updated approach that aligns with both Archdiocese expectations and Committee goals. The SAC is established to:

- Provide counsel and advice to Father Mike, Kathy Thompson and Clare Giannelli, on a variety of topics such as:
 - Financial management
 - Technology and other operating resources
 - School advancement, including curriculum, marketing, Catholic identity, and teacher/family recruitment & retention
 - Long-range planning

The SAC is not a governing body and is not responsible for implementing school policies or procedures.

The Executive Committee is committed to enhanced transparency and communication, so we plan to post approved meeting minutes on the school website and send this newsletter to all parents each month.

SAC Aligns on Goals to Support School Priorities

The SAC is comprised of 10 committees reflecting the SOSM mission and priorities outlined by administration. Ongoing committee project highlights include:

- Technology: Launch of a new Learning Management System (Blackbaud) to replace current digital platforms to improve efficiency, integration, and communication for faculty and parents; the system will be installed this year so it's ready for 2025-26.
- **Student Life:** Continued efforts to enhance our growing athletics program, as well as a new student recognition program to celebrate Crusader values.
- **Curriculum:** Research to identify optimal programming for foreign language instruction and evaluate new math textbooks for adoption by SOSM in grades K-5.
- Retention: Community-building and student experiences (e.g., "shadow day") to help engage and retain families, particularly as they move to the UGC.

- Representation from every grade, except 7th
