- h. Book Fair Carlotta Plotner/ Katie Villacis Our PGC Holiday Book Fair with Santa and Mrs. Claus will be held the week of December 2-5th, 2024. Monday will be the children's preview day with our evening event with Santa being held Thursday, December 5th from 5-7pm. The children will be able to shop Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday during the school day and in the evening Thursday. Helpers are needed for each homeroom to make wish lists on Monday, Dec. 2.

- 6. School Donations of available PA funds
 - a. School administration wish list
 - -Technology, PA has traditionally funded. Laptops, have not been upgraded since 2015 (\$8500) 18 ipads, view sonic cameras

- -Infrastructure and furniture, locker rooms, tile floor needs repair, hopefully before Christmas (Mr. Bill looking into an estimate) Patch vs. Renovation?
- -Mirror needed in locker room.
- -Multi-purpose room, more functional for staff/parent meetings, tables with electrical plugs, cabinetry for coffee, snacks, drinks, ect.
- -5th grade would also like new furniture \$15k per classroom
- -PGC library, 18 more chairs needed.
- -Second set of risers for the UGC, three sets needed, cost needed
- -Bonus for teachers, increase? Retention bonus for teachers? Roughly 35 teachers.
- -Parish subsidy?
- -Retention bonuses for talented teachers, step scale.
- -Teacher recognition at staff meetings and or drawer of gift certificates for teachers that Kathy can distribute at her discretion.
- -Teacher break rooms, ice maker, garbage disposal
- -More computers for the PGC students, 1:1 ipad model?
- -Air purifiers
- -Laminator, copier
